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

Model Analyses and Guidance (mag.ncep.noaa.gov)




Online access of real-time weather data






Easy to use interface





Easy to understand the direction, magnitude, and time






About Global Forecast System

- Main weather model used by NOAA and the weather industry
- Updates and resolution
- Data accessed via a THREDDS server, simplifying access to the 400 GB of data
- Gridded data output




Visualization Architecture





Getting Started


- Configure VizLab servers with JavaScript libraries

- Develop prototype






Challenges

- Incorporate feedback






Final Product
